1. Vendor Set up- Saturday June 20th from 8am to 10:30am. (subject to change)
2. Vendor Hours- Saturday June 20th from 10:30am to 5:00pm, You must have someone stationed at your booth 30 mins before doors open until the doors close.
3. All Vendor spaces will include 1-8' x 2.5' table and 2 chairs. You may bring more tables/chairs, for your booth. Each 10' x 10' booth space will be given 2 vendor badges. Extra badges are \$10 Each.
4. Electrical Service- You must let us know at the time of application how much amps and outlets you will need. Some extra charges may apply.
5. NO FOOD OR DRINK MAY BE IN THE MARSHALL MIDDLE SCHOOL GYMNASIUM.
6. All Vendors must display all of the merchandise within your allotted booth space.
7. Heroes Helping Heroes Expo is a FAMILY FRIENDLY Con, and requires NO R rated materials to be sold at, or shown in any form. This includes and is not limited to, DVDs, magazines, video games, art work, figurines that are deemed pornographic or sexist by Heroes Helping Heroes Expo. We reserve the right to have any vendor remove any items that are deemed R rated.
8. No Bootlegged DVDs or memorabilia may be sold. Vendors found selling bootlegged material will be removed from Heroes Helping Heroes Expo and will be subject to federal prosecution. No Refunds will be given.
